BROWN BOX (500g only)

Brown Box is a eucalyptus tree that is found in the wheat belt of New South Wales where the summers are hot and rainfall low. The honey is amber in colour with a pleasant flavour. It naturally candies after some time. This honey was produced in the Dubbo area.

COOLABAH (500g & 1Kg Glass Jars)

A small "boxy" eucalypt, found in arid and semi arid regions. The Coolabah can provide heavy flow with good honey over a short period from Mid December to late January. The honey is light in colour with excellent density and flavour.

LUCERNE (500g & 1kg Glass Jars)

Lucerne (Alfalfa) is grown for hay or in some areas pasture. Lucerne has a purplish flower and choice honey, light in colour with a mild flavour.

This honey candies naturally and quickly.

MUGGA IRON BARK (500g & 1kg Glass Jars)

Is a major source of honey in NSW. This honey was produced the Bumberry Ranges west of Manildra. The tree starts flowering in March and continues to flower during winter up until September. The tree produces honey better when the nights are frosty. One of our house favourites. A must try.

WHITE BOX (500g & 1Kg Glass Jars)

A eucalypt tree found on the Western Slopes of NSW. A most reliable source of honey with flowering occurring every 2 to 3 years. Cold nights and sunny days are necessary for good nectar flows. The honey is particularly light in colour and pleasant in flavour. This honey was produced at Cargo just west of Orange.

YELLOW BURR (500g & 1Kg Glass Jars)

(St Barnaby's Thistle) Yellow burr is common in the wheat belt on the tablelands and slopes. Flowering occurs from mid December until the frost arrives. An excellent pollen producers, with very light honey with a greenish tint, and granulates easily.

YELLOW MALLEE (500g & 1Kg Glass Jars)

(Eucalyptus incrassate) Flowers from August to April, producing cream-white-yellow blossoms, producing a dense and sticky honey that tastes like a buttery caramel.

KURRAJONG (500g & 1Kg Glass Jars)

(*Brachychiton*) Small to medium summer flowering tree growing to a height of 5-10m or more. Grown naturally in all parts of NSW, and are most common on hillsides. Not a major source of nectar, however does produce a medium amber honey, mild in flavour with a twist. Very pleasant honey that would suit most honey lovers.

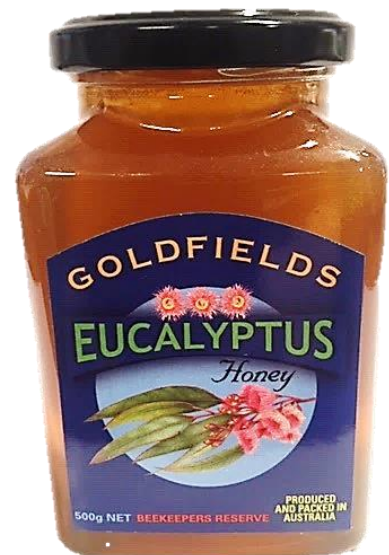
